A pledge that represents a sacrifice of 1% of each family's annual household income is a suggested starting point to prayerfully consider.

## Why are Pledges Encouraged?

Making a pledge is encouraged over one-time gifts because a PLEDGE allows you to spread your gift throughout the year, making it easier for you to pay and allowing (in most cases) a person to give a larger sacrificial gift.

Pledge statements are sent monthly by the diocese unless requested otherwise. These are simple reminders and NOT bills. Please know that you have complete flexibility to pay your pledge at any point before the end of the appeal year. If your situation changes, you may also adjust your pledge by calling the diocesan CSA office.

Please know that one-time gifts are always accepted and very much appreciated.

## Are donations tax-deductible?

Yes, gifts donated to the Diocese of Gaylord are tax-deductible. At the end of the year, the diocese will send an acknowledgement letter for tax purposes. Consult a tax professional for the actual deductibility of a gift based on individual tax situations.
